A Japanese Kenzan, also known as a "flower frog," is a spiked metal base used in the art of flower arranging (IKEBANA), originating in the late Meiji period around 1900. It anchors stems, providing stability for precise and artistic arrangements. The tool is integral to achieving harmony, balance, and simplicity in Ikebana. We have redesigned the Kenzan to beautifully complement modern lifestyles in various styles.

## HOW TO USE

1. Trim the stem to the appropriate length and insert it to needles to make the plant stand upright.
2. Pour water into the cup.
3. Follow your aesthetic sense and enjoy arranging it.
