## Pendant Lamp 41127-II-1 "Medina"

The Arabic Family

This family of lanterns originates from a large project we did for the Mosque in Medina. The design stems from the typical satellite elements which bear the lighting on outside compartments of larger chandeliers.

In this single version the frosted and skilfully painted glass shade bearing traditional Islamic enamel ornaments holds one light bulb. The frame is made from brass and gilded to a perfect finish.

This type of fixture is most suitable for long hallways, cloisters or staircases.
