



Chandelier 42343-187 "Megaron Spiral"

The Lobmeyr Worldwide Family

This chandelier was strongly inspired by its location: It lightens the main spiral staircase in Megaron Athens Concert Hall. It became our longest chandelier with almost 20 meter drop over 5 levels. It was finished and delivered just in time for the opening of the 2004 Olympic Games.

Despite its monumental proportions it proved a good model for residential projects.

The original version bears triangular crystal prisms, smaller versions were made with round rods of crystal in the spiral elements.

The smallest version ever done was only 250 cm high, still keeping its expression.
