This fixture is another spin-off from our signature Metropolitan Wall Sconce design from 1966 for the Met Opera in New York. From the flat layout with the original sconce we dragged the simple idea into the third dimension.

David Collins asked us for a long fixture over a table for an impressive dining room in North London mansion. Ice and sparkle was the general motive of inspiration. The frame is constructed so thoughtful that it took only one person to install the whole 3,5 m long fixture. A more this-worldly benefit of the design line is that the metal grids with crystals can be easily removed and processed in a dishwasher. The basic concept of this fixture now allowed to create any cubic shape with this icy-sparkly look.
