The Contemporary Family

The idea behind the Zymbel was to create a candle holder that would reflect and amplify the glow from a single candle with a bit of 'theatre'. The form is based on four shifting discs, whose composition can be changed as desired, that move around a candle in spherical space. The weighted base allows the other three discs to cantilever up and around the candle producing a gravity defying appearance. The rear discs can be tensioned or repositioned via a handmade butterfly nut on the back. The candle visually floats above the disc via a central spike.

The base and the outer faces of the reflectors are highly polished. The inner sides of the reflectors are unvarnished and have a special brushed finish to accent their mutual swivel axis. To keep these surfaces from tarnishing a thin coat of oranges' oil is recommended to be applied time and again. Partly also because of the lovely smell.
