



## Chandelier 4713-5 "Parisian"

The Haerdtl Family

Designed for the World Exhibition in Paris 1937 this is the most prominent work of Oswald Haerdtl, one of our most important designers. It is the best example of Haerdtl's play with light floral shapes and heavily cut crystal. Through its slender body it emanates a noble elegance. This is even enhanced by the almost lavishly long candles.

The chandelier is made of brass with a polished or antique finish.
