Even among the most elegant works of Oswald Haerdtl this item sticks out with its playful walk between minimalism and decoration. The stern cut bowl gives a strong presence contradicted by the long stem. A cut crystal star at the base and the typical floral element at the crown give the fixture the perfect frame. The cut bowl bears a sophisticated cut that creates the illusion of a mirror finish breaking all looks back upon themselves. Yet the light can pass unhindered creating the softest of lighting effects.
