The Jugendstil Family

A typical ceiling lamp of the Jugendstil period with the signature glass tubes. The two tiers of tubes refract the light of the central light bulb charmingly creating a lovely play of light along the tubes.

The metal skirting can be made in many metal finishes and is suitable for installation directly to the ceiling. Various options for installation as a pendant as well as addition of more light bulbs into the body are possible.
